Emotional Health and Wellbeing Panel

Over the last few years, lots of families have received support through the presenting of cases at the Emotional Health and Wellbeing Panel. Children who have been presented have gone onto the ADHD and ASD pathways with Bee-U, received support from the school nursing team, the mental health practitioners and the BSAT team to name a few. It has been agreed that the Local Authority will no longer manage the referrals into the Bee U service, and that the Emotional Health and Wellbeing panel as it currently exists will not continue. Bee U has made a decision that they will now accept referrals directly from schools as access referrals, and will communicate directly with schools and parents about decisions made on acceptance onto pathways. Please come and talk to me in school if you would like more information about this referral pathway.


