

# Maths

All children have been given a TT Rockstars username and password. We ask that children log in and practise their timestables for at least ten minutes per week. This is an incredibly effective method for getting children to learn a crucial maths skill, which has massive impacts on their progress.

Take opportunities to extend your child's learning when outside of school - can they estimate how much money has been spent when out shopping? Ask them to calculate your change. Which is the better value for money? Baking is a fun (and hopefully delicious) way of getting children to use measures. Can they convert between units of measures?
