



To focus on Technical Knowledge making sure that each year group has good coverage. Perhaps through a DT day!

Lead staff meeting in order to ensure consistency across the school when teaching DT. Allowing staff members, especially new members, the opportunity to ask questions and develop their knowledge of DT prior to delivery.

Ensure that teaching and learning of DT across school is of a high standard and sequenced demonstrating coverage of substantive and disciplinary knowledge and the development and understanding of DT vocabulary.

Continue to develop differentiation within lessons for GDS and SEND pupils through the development implementation of our bespoke curriculum, developed with our pupils' needs at its heart. Ensuring clear progression across the school.

Continue to develop cross curricular links between D and T and core subjects. Engaging children through discussion:  
Where is maths used in DT?  
When is Literacy used in DT?

Continue to develop IT and implement the use of IT across the DT curriculum.

Leading on from links with specialist STEM teacher, reach out to secondary schools in order to use specialist equipment. Developing the pupils cultural capital.

Review Healthy eating week and implement any required changes to ensure coverage and efficiency.

Elevate the pupils aspirations leading the F1 club and Lego club.

DT vocabulary to be a focus during sessions building on the substantive knowledge that the pupils have learned the previous year.

Continue to develop the DT area on the website. Demonstrating and engaging and passionate curriculum.

Organise kitchen area and stock. Link with Asda and local companies to improve facilities.
