

A 'deep dive' will take place to monitor and enable continual development of the quality of teaching and learning.

We will continue to embed pupils' understanding of our British Values and core Christian values and how our curriculum enables them to become Agents for Change, being responsible, respectful and active citizens with a strong understanding of the Christian faith and morals.

PSHEE and RSHE will be assessed at the end of each unit to inform next steps in learning.



The PSHEE and RSHE curriculum will be adapted in light of the 2025 DFE review.

We will work in partnership with parents to explore opportunities for them to be involved in the key messages of the PSHEE/RSHE curriculum (Be More Curriculum).

Wider opportunities for deeper spiritual reflection will be explored by experimenting with different types of 'Big Questions' within the PSHEE and RSHE curriculum in order to allow children more freedom in their spiritual responses.

We will continue to embed the culture of safeguarding by finding opportunities for pupils to develop a global safeguarding perspective within the PSHEE and wider curriculum.

We will find opportunities for extended writing in PSHEE and RSHE using technical vocabulary.
