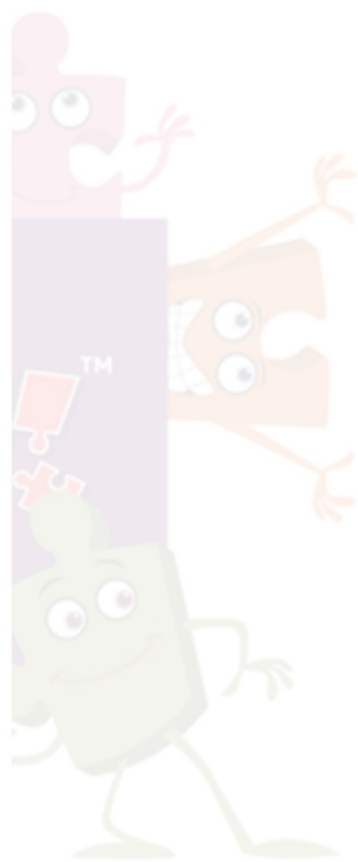
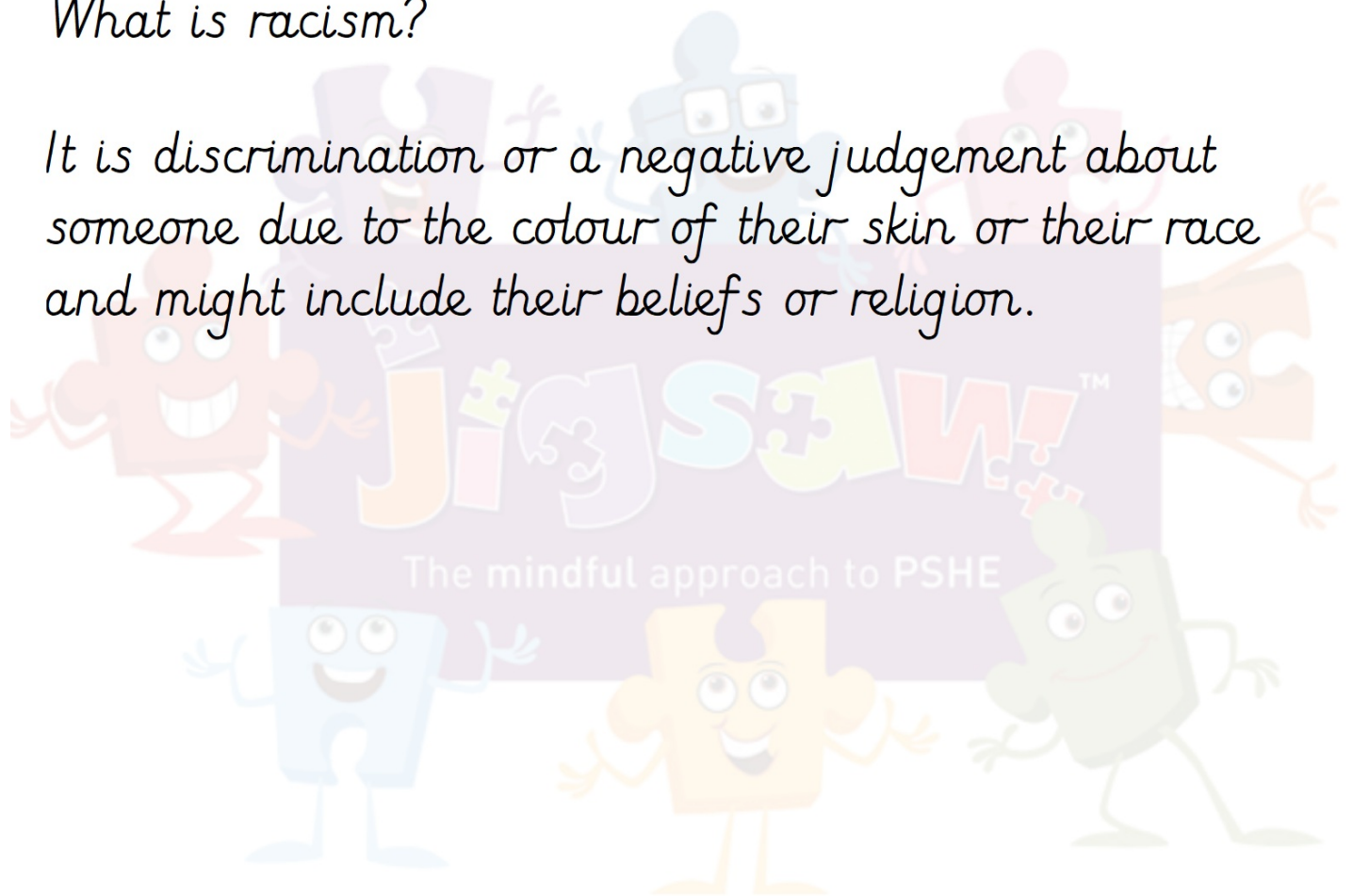

Abdul likes football and Atira likes to make Lego models.



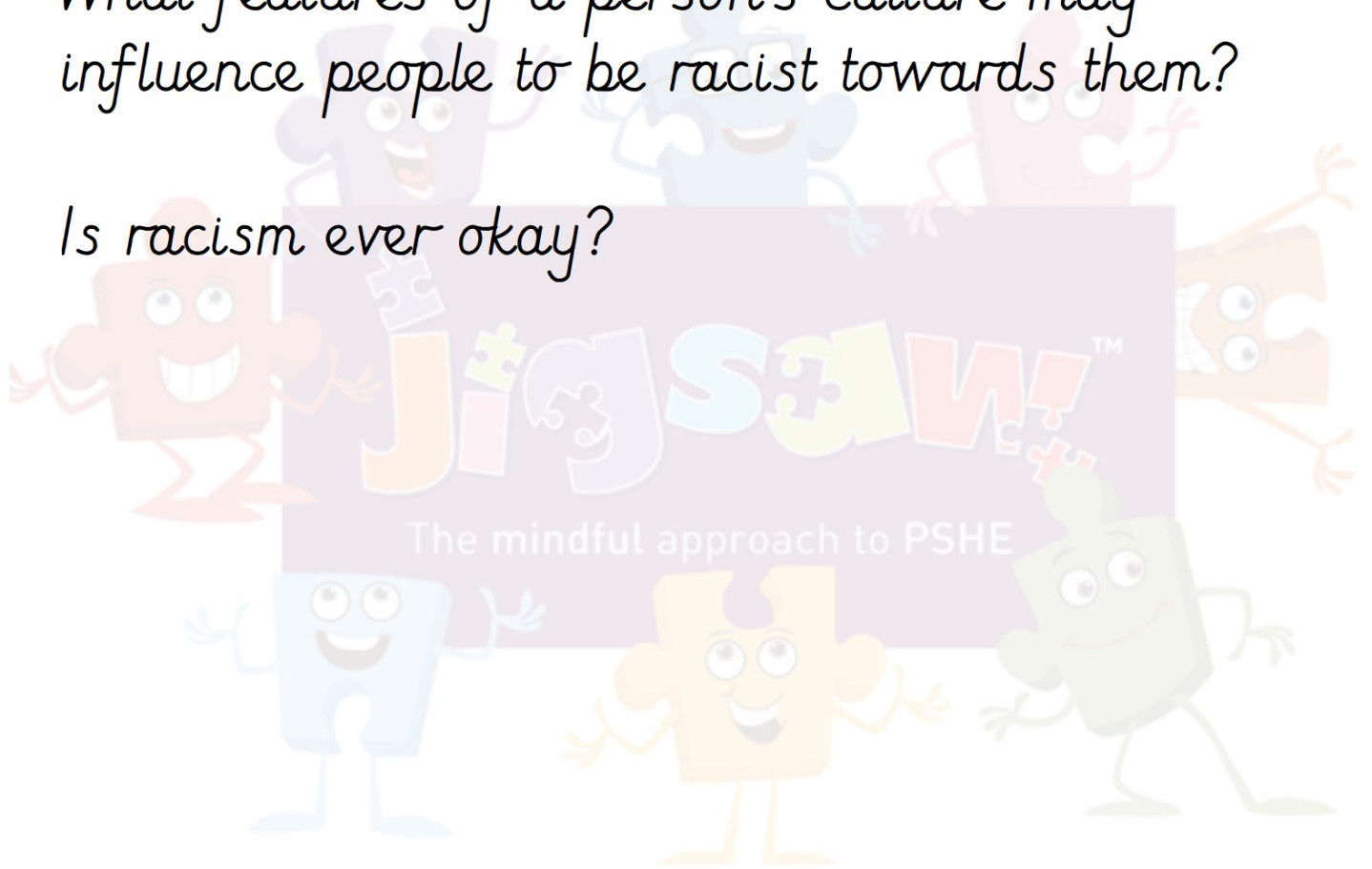

Is racism ever okay?





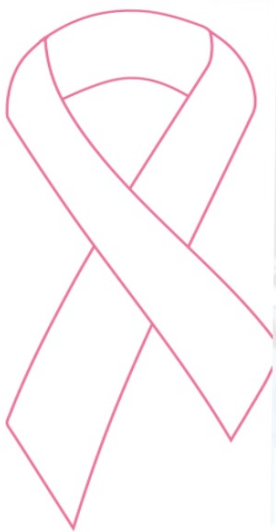
Has anyone seen this symbol before?
