

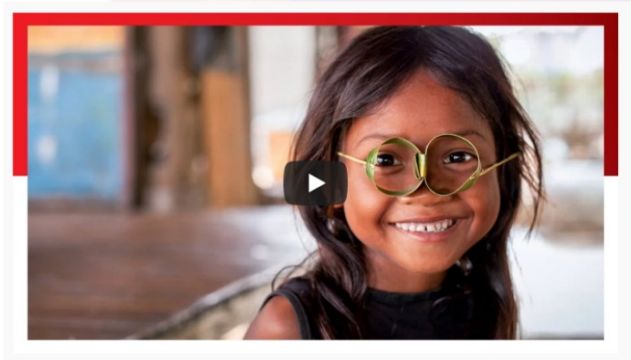

What charities could we try and support that will in turn, help people in other countries, who are less fortunate than us?



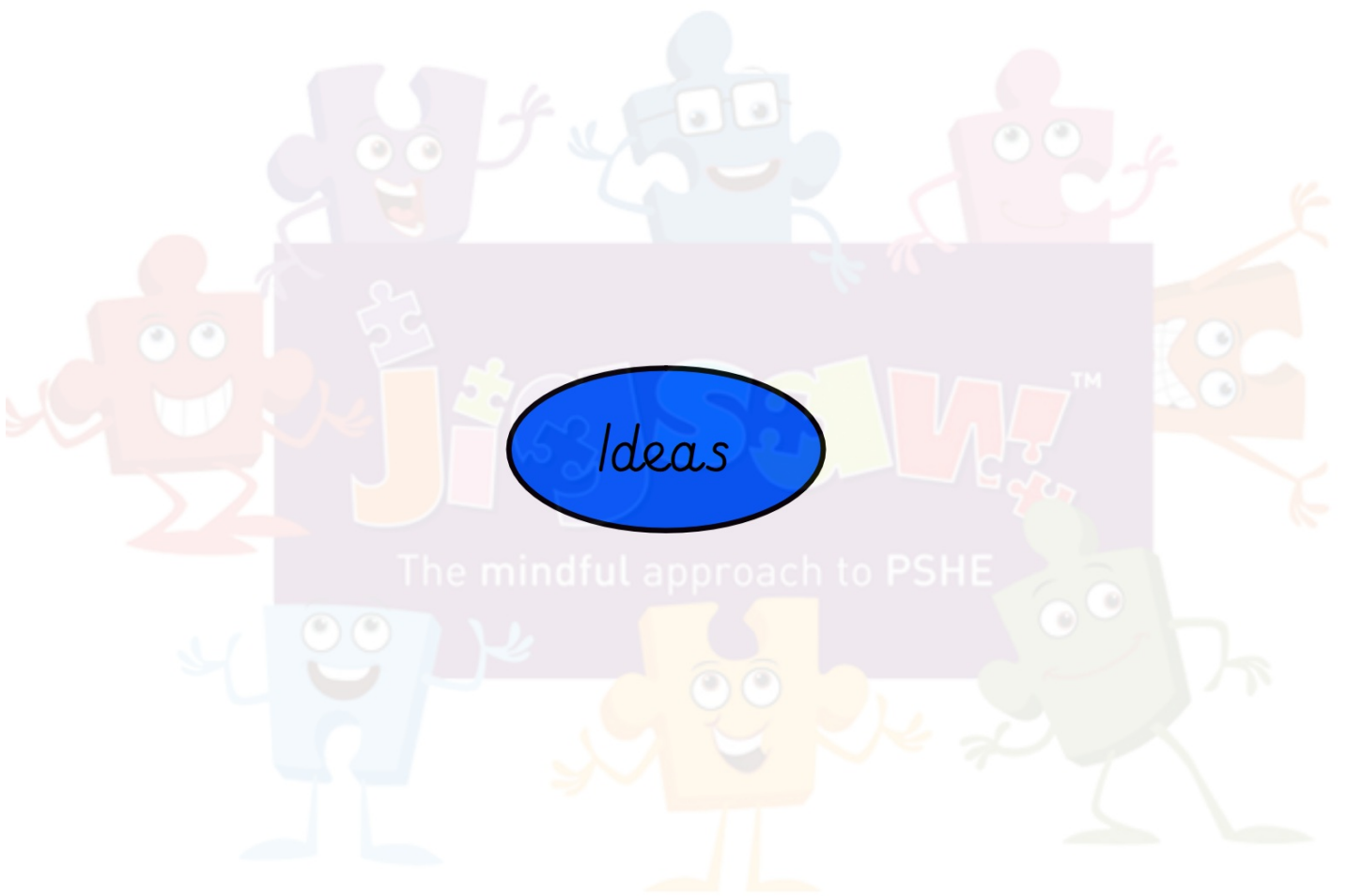
Your challenge today:
