

Whole School Reading Requirements



Individual Reading

All children take home an appropriate book from the reading scheme or a free reader book (members of staff can advise children about which books will challenge them.)

Reading for pleasure

All children have access to a variety of extra texts from the library and are encouraged to read a variety of text types.

Frequency of Reading

Every child is heard read (1:1) at least once a week. Targeted children are given further support and heard reading (1:1) at least twice a week. Some children will be completing Speedy Reading once a day. Reading data informs this. Reading record and book is in school with the pupils daily.

Love to Read

Guided reading, using the principles of Reading Domains (different skills children need to become competent readers), takes place daily and is completed in whole classes to allow all assessment strands to be covered. Targeted children will complete RWI sessions or Fresh Start.
