#### **Year 4 Parents**

Your child will be taking part in the MTC between Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> June and Friday 13<sup>th</sup> June. We are aiming to complete the check for all children as soon as we can. This check is to test pupils on their multiplication facts for the timetables between 1-12 within a recorded time. The children will have 6 seconds to answer each question that will consist of 25 questions.

Over half term, I would recommend that your child uses the following website to practise as it is within the same timed conditions and allows you to see the score and which multiplication facts they are struggling with.

By practising over half term, this will allow them to feel more prepared and confident when they complete the test after half term. Multiplication skills underpin the Maths Curriculum in UKS2 and having these core skills will stand them I good stead for year 5.




were an absolute delight to take and received wonderful





compliments about their manners and behaviour from the


residents and the employees at the home. We hope that our visit left the residents feeling joyful.
